Background

- Training Objectives in the EMILIA Project
 - To develop accredited work-based learning training programmes, ranging from prevention to recovery, open to both service users and mental health staff.
 - To develop a pan-European, flexible, accredited modular system for the accumulation of credits and academic awards.
 - To create training models that will enable European mental health services to undertake a process of continuous quality improvement, from prevention to recovery.

Technical Annex

- 6.0 Implementation Plan
 - WP 6 (Aarhus) coordinates the development of appropriate training packages geared to assist the development of new employment opportunities for service users.
 - WP 9 (Bodø) disseminates and valorise the training through a interactive approach

The story so far

- We have developed 11 training programmes
- They have been piloted in various forms/degrees in the demonstration sites.
- The majority have picked bits and pieces from the different programs in order to tailor them to their user's needs
- Athens, Aarhus and Paris have evaluated this.



Final solution

- Aarhus and Bodø have collaborated on producing final versions of the training programs.
- We have worked towards this final solution/conclusion:
 - Internet based EMILIA Training Programs rather than a CD-rom
 - All the original programs are available in a common format
 - Possibility to tailor a training to the user's needs.
 - Recommended that all programs start with an introductory module
 - Plus always possible to go back to the original programmes.
