



Sub-study 2: develop, piloting and evaluate selected interventions





Background:

Aim:

- Experiences and everyday life after the loss of a beloved
- To identify psychosocial needs

Methods:

- Co-operative inquiry (Heron, 1996)
- Qualitative semi-structured interview study (Kvale, 2009; Coffey, A. & Atkinson, P. 1996)

Data:

- 15 interviews with 20 interviewees
- Lost a loved one to suicide at age 61 79 years

Co-researcher: Interviewing



Co-operative thematical analysis



1) Working group for analysis with 4 pairs









2) Reference group meeting



3) Analysis in the working group



Each interview:

- 1) Holistic reading
- 2) Coding
- 3) Categories

Analysis across all interviews:

- Input from the reference group (relevant professionals, bereaved by suicide and researchers)
- Themes



Co-researcher: to analyze



Findings:



Older adults may need:

- Professional partners who know what they are doing and can assist
- Sympathetic lay people in their social network
- General knowledge about deaths by suicide
- Knowledge about possible reactions, feelings and responses
- To deal with their new life conditions
- To meet other people bereaved by suicide

For co-researchers collaborative research is:

- Time consuming
- Demanding
- May contribute to recovery
